Position scope

Reporting to the Business Development Team Lead, this is an intermediate role responsible for financial modelling and business case writing that supports the customer value proposition.

- Responsible for modelling, scenario analysis, case writing and pitch book creation and support.
- Integration/coordination with CE's corporate finance, accounting and commercial projects teams to ensure integrity of methods, data and assumptions across the company.

Responsibilities

- Develop, maintain and improve the financial models for Direct Air Capture and AIR TO FUELS™ plants in different international jurisdictions.
- Collaborate with internal stakeholders and external corporate partners to refine and calibrate model dataset.
- Create and maintain business development related pitch books.
- Qualitative analysis to supplement and explain financial models and value propositions to third parties.
- Research tax and other country-specific policies and regulations and integrate into models.
- Work with the Accounting team to keep abreast of market conditions as they relate to tax and accounting matters (e.g., IFRS & US GAAP) that may impact the models.
- Support the Business Development team in working with plant developers, investors, banks, and insurance companies to determine optimal plant economics in order to accelerate commercialization.
- Develop customer-oriented investment material and support customers on loan and financing applications.

Qualifications

- Bachelor's Degree in finance or accounting.
- CFA Charterholder or candidate, or CPA designation.
- Completion of a financial modelling course is desirable (e.g. Marquee Group or similar).
